September 2 ZOO EVENT A WALK ON THE WILD SIDE

A major attraction in the city of Minot is the Roosevelt Park Zoo. Did you know a recent renovation project has been taking place and First Western Bank & Trust was a major contributor? Plan to see their new renovations and upgrades, especially the habitat for the rare Amur Tiger and enclosure for the African Lion. The Zoo is the first one in the state of ND, opening in 1920, so it has a long tradition. The Zoo has the tall reticulated giraffe, children's Discovery Barn and over 159 animals and birds to name just a few of its features. For your comfort one will find benches, restrooms, hand sanitizer stations and plenty of room to practice social distancing in this beautiful space. A free admission is

offered to all club members for Wednesday, September 2. If this is your first time to the Minot Zoo, the address is 1219 Burdick Expressway East.

You will find ample parking out front of the Zoo on the south side. Walk across the bridge to enter the visitor center. We will meet in the auditorium located next to the restrooms in the visitor center. In the auditorium, we will pass out admission tickets and a concession stand coupon to use inside the Zoo. The concession stand food coupon is good for a hot dog, chips, drink and ice cream treat only. Plan to pick up your tickets and concession coupons between 10:30 am-12:30 pm. The Zoo is open until 6:00 pm that day. To avoid a long line and congregating in the hall, use these guidelines: If your last name is A–N come between

10:30 am and 11:30 am to pick up your ticket and concession food coupon, and if your last name is O-Z come between 11:30 am and 12:30 pm. You now have your admission ticket, a concession stand food coupon and are ready to enter the zoo. (If some of you

are car pooling, pick the time that works best for the group).

You can spend the whole day and/or whatever time frame you wish on your selfguided visit. Remember the free admission and the free concession stand coupon is good for September 2 only. You will not be disappointed! Wear comfortable shoes and jackets if needed. Call 852-3711 to reserve your spot by August 31st, as we need to have an accurate count. Can't wait to see you at the Zoo!
